# welcome.



**At the outset I would like to take the opportunity, on behalf of the Trustees, to wish you all well.**

Whilst all of our lives have been impacted as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, I hope you have been able to stay safe, positive and in good spirits.

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## The new normal

Despite the disruption caused by recent events, I am pleased to report that the Scheme carried on running all its operations remotely and our Scheme administrators, Hymans Robertson, have done a brilliant job of continuing to administer the Scheme to a high standard (including paying pensions on time!), despite them all working from home.

From a Trustee perspective, we are now holding our regular meetings by video conference which, whilst not the same as meeting face-to-face, has enabled us to continue to meet as usual as well as linking up with our advisers who are also working from home – we were even able to meet 'virtually' with a new investment manager based in the United States! It has also been nice to see the wide variety of homes, families and on occasion, pets, that we all have. No doubt some of you will have had similar experiences of remote working.

Given the current restrictions, can I encourage you to check the Scheme website regularly as this has become a key tool for the Trustees to issue information and updates to members about the Scheme. Details on how to register for online access can be found on page 5.



## Business as (un)usual

On the day the Government announced the lockdown restrictions, the Company made a decision to immediately close all of its show homes, sales centres and construction sites in the interests of safety. Whilst this will clearly have an impact on the Company's performance during the year, the senior management team have been very clear that the decision was the right thing to do in the circumstances and have since implemented a series of measures in order to protect the business.

Throughout the shutdown period the Trustees have been in regular dialogue with the Company who have been open and transparent about the Company's position and the decisions that have been taken. In particular, Chris Carney (Group Finance Director), has attended a number of meetings with the Trustees in order to provide information and take questions. The Trustees were therefore pleased to see the phased re-opening of construction sites and sales centres from May. Whilst it is clearly not going to be 'business as usual' for a little while yet, these are positive steps in the right direction.

More recently, the Company has raised approximately £522 million via a share placing. The Company intends to use these funds to invest in land acquisition opportunities. The Trustees view the share placing positively as it will support the Company's sustainable growth and deliver attractive returns in the future.

## A key focus for 2020

As you would expect, along with many other pension schemes in the UK, the COVID-19 crisis has impacted the Scheme's funding position. Further details can be found on page 7 but whilst the funding level has fallen, we have been pleased that our investment strategy approach has protected the Scheme from a more significant fall. The Trustees are currently in the process of conducting a full actuarial valuation of the Scheme as at 31 December 2019, and the results of the

valuation are likely to be known in early 2021, once an agreement has been reached with the Company over future contributions. This will continue to be a key focus for the Trustees during 2020.

## A new option for pensioners

Although it seems like a slightly distant memory, the Company carried out a Pension Increase Exchange exercise (PIE) in Autumn 2019 where certain eligible members (essentially those members with pensions earned before 6 April 1997) were given the option to exchange future pension increases for a higher flat rate pension. I am pleased to report that over 1,000 pensioners accepted the offer, having first taken financial advice from an independent financial adviser appointed for the exercise. The option for a higher flat rate pension is also now available to all eligible members at retirement.

## Thank you, Paula

Lastly, can I place on record my thanks to Paula Wright who decided to step down from the Trustee board in March. Paula has been a member-nominated trustee for over 6 years having first joined the board when the former schemes merged in 2013. I would like to thank her for all her hard work during that time and to wish her well for the future. With Paula stepping down, there is now a vacancy for a new member-nominated Trustee. Details of the nomination and selection process are included in the enclosed leaflet.

I do hope you enjoy reading this edition of intouch and find the new look to it a refreshing change. As always, if you have any comments or suggestions for future editions then please do contact us.

# COVID-19

## *our response*

Since lockdown began, we have all been working from home using secure remote access to ensure that operations have been able to continue as normal.

Hymans Robertson, the Scheme's administrators, have a robust Business Continuity Plan and have made it a priority to process payments, set up forthcoming retirements and respond to enquiries. You can contact them as normal via their contact details on the back page.

### Rest assured

Please be assured that the Scheme assets remain safe and that contingency arrangements are in place to ensure that pensions will continue to be paid as usual.

As the crisis emerged, the Trustees took the prudent step to hold sufficient cash in the Scheme bank account to cover 3 months' benefits payments, including pensioner payroll. Further details on the steps taken can be found on the Scheme website.

### Company contributions

The Company's number one priority during the crisis has been the health, safety and wellbeing of its employees, subcontractors and customers. As a result, the Company took an early decision to close its construction sites and sales outlets. During this time, the Company took a number of measures to protect the business, including cancelling its 2020 final dividend and planned special dividend to shareholders.

As part of its efforts to preserve cash, the Company asked for a short suspension of the monthly contributions that it pays to the Scheme – a total of £10 million. Having considered all of the available information with our advisers, the Trustees were satisfied that the proposal was in the best interest of all parties and so supported the Company's request having taken into account guidance issued by The Pensions Regulator.

### Paying back the contributions

The Trustees have agreed a mechanism with the Company which ensures that the money is paid back into the Scheme, with interest, in early 2021. The Company has also agreed to provide regular updates to the Trustees on all relevant financial developments.

# Report and *Accounts*

Each year, the Trustees are required to prepare the Scheme's Annual Report and Financial Statements. This sets out the financial details of the Scheme over each year with the latest Report showing the position at 31 December 2019. The financial details from this year's Report are shown below (all figures are shown in £million):

As you can see, the net assets of the Scheme increased over the period as a result of Company contributions and the increase in the value of investments less payments to members and transfers out.

# An update on the Scheme's funding

The funding position of the Scheme at 31 December 2019 was around 97% funded, and was on track to be fully funded by the end of 2020. This was due to a combination of Company contributions and good investment returns.

Due to COVID-19, the Scheme's funding level has fallen as global stock markets fell during March 2020. At the same time, long-term interest rates have also fallen which has increased the value of the Scheme's liabilities. At the end of March 2020, the estimated funding level had dropped to around 90% funded, representing a deficit of around £250 million.

Whilst this is disappointing, the Scheme has been protected from a more significant fall due to its diversified investment strategy and high levels of interest rate / inflation hedging and the position has already started to recover during recent months. The Trustees will continue to monitor the Scheme's funding position and investments, with support from the Scheme's actuary and investment advisers.

## Scheme Valuation

Every three years the actuary to the Scheme runs a full valuation of the Scheme's assets and liabilities. The results help the Trustees decide on the future strategy of the Scheme to ensure that members are protected and the Scheme continues to be financially stable.

As part of the valuation, the Trustees and Scheme actuary will:

- review all of the Scheme's data to make sure that it is complete and accurate;
- make certain assumptions in order to place a value on the Scheme's benefits (for example, what inflation will be in the future, how long members will live for etc);
- calculate a present value of the Scheme's future benefits; and
- if the valuation shows that there is a deficit, discuss with the Company how to make good any shortfall.

## When is the next actuarial valuation?

Since the Scheme's last valuation took place at the end of 2016, a full actuarial valuation of the Scheme as at 31 December 2019 is now in progress.

The Trustees hope to agree the valuation with the Company in early 2021 and will let you know the results on the Scheme website.

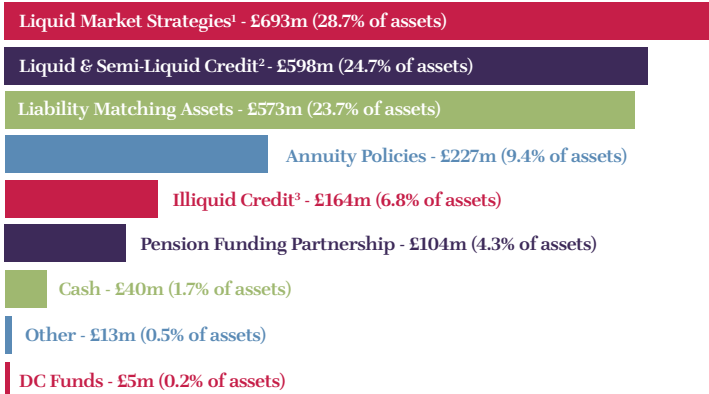
# The Scheme's investments

The Trustees invest the Scheme assets in a wide range of investments with the aim of:

- ensuring the Scheme has sufficient funds with which to pay member pensions;
- matching movements in the Scheme's liabilities by hedging changes in interest rates and inflation; and
- growing the Scheme assets to help reduce the Scheme deficit.

During 2019, we continued to work closely with our investment adviser, Redington, to ensure that the Scheme's investment strategy remains appropriate and covers a range of asset classes. No significant changes to the investment strategy were implemented during 2019 although the Trustees continue to monitor whether there are attractive investment opportunities available that might enhance the strategy.

At the end of 2019, the Scheme's assets were invested as follows:

## Appointment of new investment managers in 2020

In the first half of 2020, the Trustees appointed two new investment managers:

- Magnetar Financial LLC (in order to maintain the Scheme's allocation to illiquid investments) and
- TCW Group (to invest in a new US opportunity that has arisen out of the COVID-19 crisis).

These investments were implemented during May and June 2020.

## In the news

### Beware of Pension Scams

With the current COVID-19 crisis, now more than ever criminals have an opportunity to approach pension scheme members, savers and investors (especially the more vulnerable in our society) who may be worried about their finances.

Scams are becoming increasingly more sophisticated, often disguised with believable websites, testimonials and materials which make them look like the real thing. If you don't spot this as fraudulent activity, you could end up disclosing personal or financial information allowing the criminal to misuse your data for fraudulent purposes.

Here are some signs that you should look out for:

- being cold-called or texted out of the blue;
- being told you can access your pension before age 55 – this can only be done in very exceptional circumstances;
- any mention of phrases like "free pension review", "early pension release", "pension loans", "better investment opportunities", "time limited offer" or "legal loopholes";
- a suggestion that you set up your own company and / or pension scheme;
- communications beginning "Dear client" or "Dear valued customer"; or
- requests for any personal information such as your National Insurance number or bank details.

### Brexit

As of 31 January 2020, the UK officially withdrew from the European Union and is now in a transition period until 31 December 2020. At the current time this has no impact for the operation of the Scheme, and we continue to be able to make payments overseas. However, the Trustees will continue to monitor the situation closely.

### State Pension increase

Each year, the Government increases the amount of the State Pension. From 6 April 2020, the basic State Pension increased to £134.25 per week and the new State Pension increased to £175.20 per week. This is based on having paid full National Insurance Contributions. Note that the new State Pension applies for all retirements after 6 April 2016. To check how much you might get then go to [www.gov.uk/check-state-pension](http://www.gov.uk/check-state-pension).

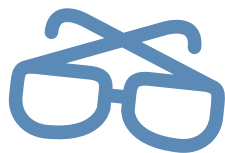
### When can I claim my State Pension?

The state pension age for both men and women has been gradually increasing and will reach age 66 by October 2020. The Government is planning further increases which will again raise the State Pension age to 67 for everyone by 2028.

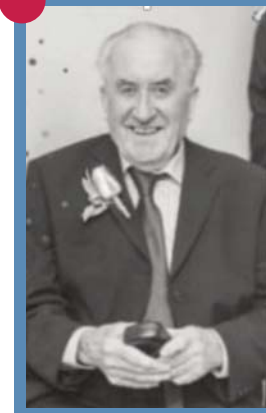
